

Eduroam Configuration Assistant Tool (CAT)

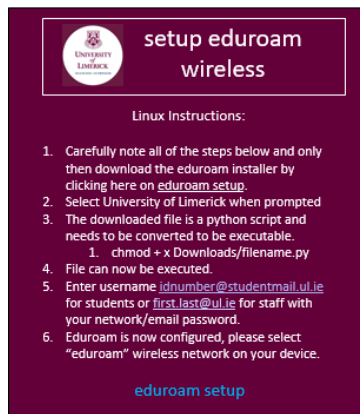
Linux Device

The Eduroam CAT tool is a customised installer which will configure your wireless card for access to the UL eduroam wireless service. The following instructions are for a Linux Devices.

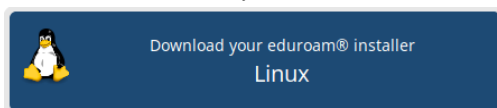
1. Select setup_eduroam wireless network.
2. Open a browser and search for any website and it will automatically redirect you to the below page.



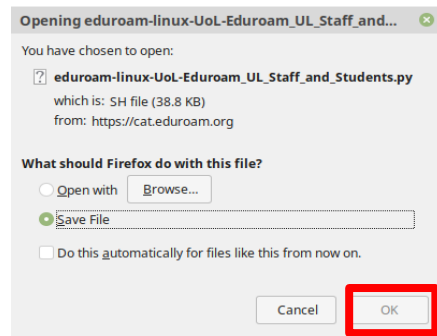
3. After you click connect you will be redirected to www.ul.ie/eduroam with a step by step guide to install the eduroam wireless profile for your device.
 - a. If you receive a certificate error go directly to www.ul.ie/eduroam



4. After you have read these steps please click on "eduroam setup" located on this page and you will be redirected to the <https://cat.eduroam.org> to download the eduroam wireless profile.
5. Select "Click here to download your eduroam installer".
6. Select "University of Limerick" from the list of institutions.
7. Your operating system should be automatically detected.
8. Click on 'Download your eduroam installer'.



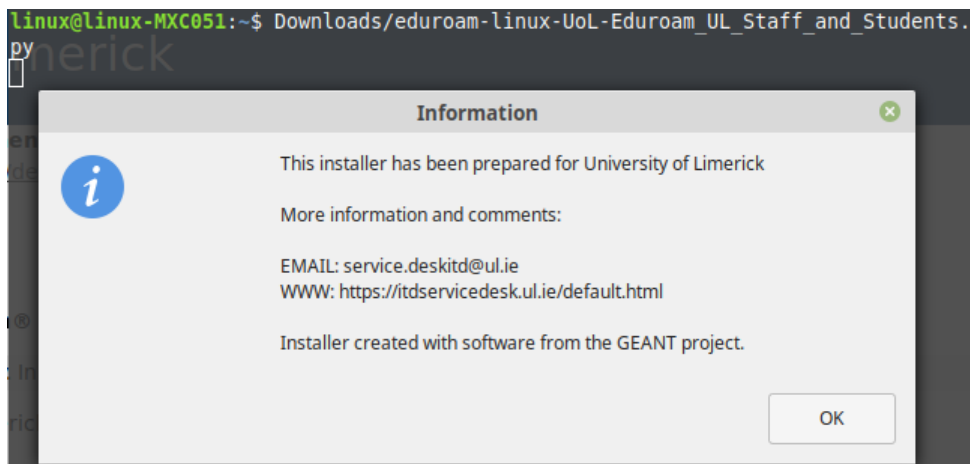
9. You will get prompted with the below screen. Select “ok” to download the eduroam wireless profile script.



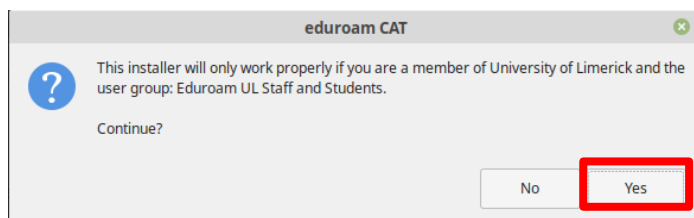
10. The downloaded script needs to be made executable. In terminal run the below command.
- Downloads is the location the file is saved. You may have chosen a different location.
 - `chmod +x Downloads/eduroam-linux-UoL-Eduroam_UL_Staff_and_Students.py`

```
linux@linux-MXC051:~$ chmod +x Downloads/eduroam-linux-UoL-Eduroam_UL_Staff_and_Students.py
```

11. Then run the executable
- `Downloads/eduroam-linux-UoL-Eduroam_UL_Staff_and_Students.py`




12. Select “Yes” for this screen to continue the install.




13. Enter your username and network password and click okay:

- a. N.B For staff type in the form firstname.lastname@ul.ie
- b. N.B For students type in the form studentid@studentmail.ul.ie
