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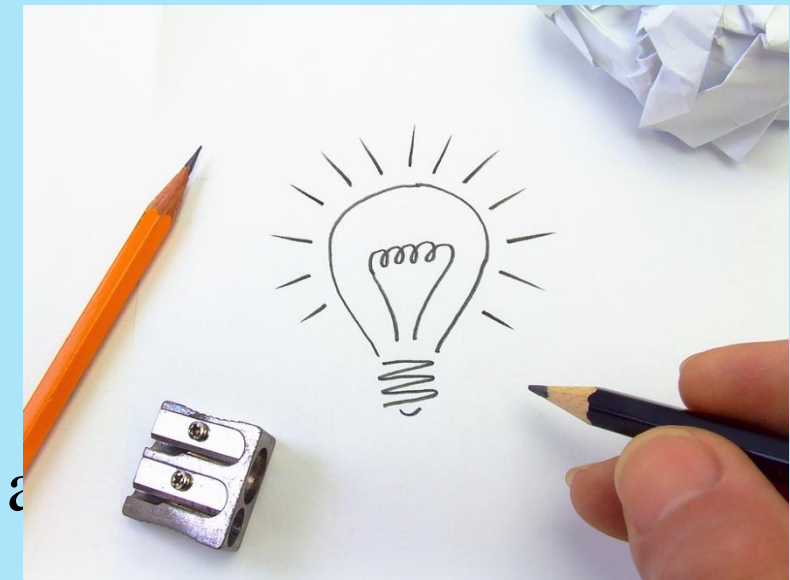

- o Run by the RWC for secondary school students.



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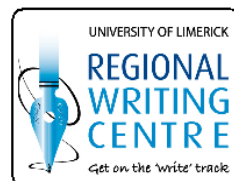
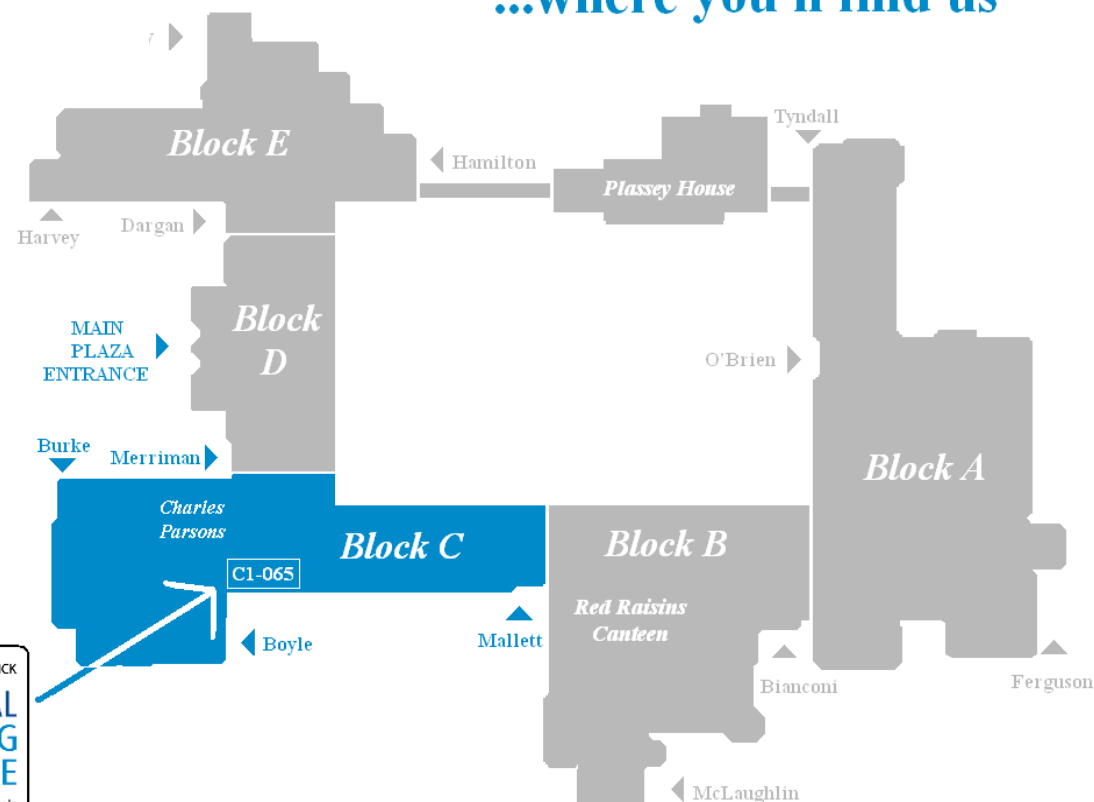
